Maine judges criticize ICE

Federal judges in Maine and Massachusetts sharply criticized U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) for filing false court documents and ignoring judicial orders, actions that led to multiple detainees being ordered released. In one case, an ICE official admitted under oath that documents submitted to a court were not authored by him and contained false information. Four federal judges have since demanded ICE comply with their orders or immediately release detainees, reflecting growing judicial frustration with the agency's conduct in immigration cases.
