BDN ARTICLE ON IMMIGRATION ENFORCEMENT <<<

The Bangor City Council voted on Monday to comply with a new State law

The Bangor City Council voted to begin complying immediately with a new Maine state law that limits how local governments can cooperate with federal immigration enforcement agencies. The law, which is expected to take effect in July, prohibits local law enforcement from detaining or searching people solely for immigration enforcement purposes and restricts sharing certain information or resources with federal immigration authorities. City officials said Bangor already has little interaction with federal immigration enforcement, but the 6–3 vote directs city staff to formally follow the new rules and establish procedures for responding to requests from immigration agents.
